The first rounds of the WCKC are fast approaching and we wanted to send out a quick bulletin with some common questions that are being asked with some answers.

- 1) **Practice** – CKRC has local test and tune on every Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday. Any out of town people can practice on those days for a cost of \$40 purchased through the CKRC Motorsports Reg. Starting on Monday May 21 to Thursday May 24 any driver racing for a Rotax Grand Final ticket **CANNOT** practice in their Mini Max, Rotax Jr or Rotax Sr kart on these days. If you are racing in another classes that is not a Grand Final class, then you may practice in that kart. Friday May 25 practice will be open to all racers from 12-9pm.
- 2) **Registration** – WCKC has had the registration open for many months now on www.wckc.ca. Anyone that is not a CKRC member is to register through the Motorsport Reg on the WCKC website. All CKRC members that are not registering for a Rotax Grand Final entry is to use the CKRC Motorsport Reg.
- 3) **Lottery Motors** – The lottery motors will be handed out on Thursday May 24 so drivers can get the motors ready on their karts prior to Friday practice. All components supplied with lottery motors **MUST** be used and exchanging parts is **NOT** allowed. (ie carb, airbox and ecu)
- 4) **Supplementary Regulations** – The supplementary regulations are posted on the www.wckc.ca website. Be sure to check it out as the WCKC does make the odd change. There is a date on it to when it was last changed.
- 5) **Transponders** – If anyone has a X2 transponder we require them to make sure that they have synced the transponder to your account before coming to the event. This is to prevent any problems with timing and scoring.
- 6) **Tires** – At the event each driver is only allowed **ONE** set of tires to race the entire weekend per kart. If a driver wants to practice on Friday they are again only allowed to use **ONE** set of tires during any practice sessions from Friday – Sunday. Make sure not to mix up any tires and if the wrong tires are on the kart could cause a DQ.
- 7) **Volunteers** – We are looking for anyone that is could help with doing track duties on Friday May 25th from 12-9pm. With doing these duties of the volunteering they will be credited a \$200 entry fee to the next WCKC rounds in Martensville on July 6-8.
